Comstock hereby certify that I am a Registered Civil Engineer of the State of California; that this map consisting of two sheets, correctly represents a survey made by me in June 1932, that all of the monuments shown thereon consisting of iron pins actually exist and that their positions are correctly shown.

We also hereby dedicate for public use easements for public utilities under or over those certain strips of land lying between the rear lines and/or side lines of lots and the lines each designated as "Easement 5' wide" and "Easement 10' wide" as shown on said map within said subdivision, and also those certain strips of land lying outside of said subdivision between the boundary thereof and the lines designated as "Easement 5 ft. wide" and "Easement 10 ft. wide" as shown on said map, reserving to ourselves the right to include said strips of land lying outside of said subdivision in future subdivisions, but without the right to extinguish or modify the easements in, on, or under said strips of land; such strips of land to be kept open and free from buildings and structures of any kind.








